Rescuers Battle Weather, Time, to Reach **Russian Sub**

(Reuters) - Rescuers repeatedly sent rescue capsules into murky, choppy water overnight in increasingly frenzied efforts to get to a stricken submarine and reach over 100 Russian sailors no longer showing signs of life. The West prepared to help rescue the



crew of the Kursk nuclear submarine grounded on the seabed of the Arctic Barents Sea since the weekend, but there were fears it would come too late as the vessel's oxygen levels fell. More...
